1 CANVA

Use this app or website to make anything you write more visually appealing. Has tons of helpful templates if you need to make a presentation, poster, newsletter or just want to use graphics to make your information stand out.

2 EVERNOTE

You know when you have a great idea or see a helpful picture or article. Maybe you write it down, take a screen shot? Well once you sign up for a free evernote account, you can save it to previously created folders and refer back to it whenever you want. Without looking for a piece of paper or using all of the storage on your phone.

3 ZOOM

A free video chat platform that is great for networking, sharing ideas when it's not possible to all be in the same place and phone call is less than ideal.

4 TED TALKS
